Project Updates

Update on first DPLA ingest:

- Initial feed included 89,262 records -
 - 35,560 records contributed by 71 institutions from 3Rs council hosted collections:
 - 23,890 - New York Heritage
 - 8,892 - Long Island Memories
 - 3,228 - HRVH
 - 53,702 records from the New York State Library
- DPLA still working with our data to roll out their new ingest system. They are projecting that our content will be live by DPLAFest in April.
- ESDN data and processes look good and we're ready to begin growing content for Phase 2 of the project plan.

Scheduling ongoing ESDN ingests:

- Beginning in April ESDN will begin harvesting from our partners every month. The monthly schedule will be available for liaisons on the first tab of the Hosted Contributor tracking spreadsheet.
- The process is very manual - each data set has to be reloaded individually (for example, there are around 50 sets currently in NYH - each of those will need to be manually re-ingested into REPOX).
- Once their new ingest system is online, DPLA will harvest from us monthly.

Project Goals for Phase 2:

- Expand the contributor base.
- Understand and define our capacity to grow.
- Harness the metadata group:
 - Recruit metadata specialists from partner/member institutions.
 - Establish guidelines and best-practices for sharing data with ESDN.
 - Sponsor data related events in the regions.
- Investigating sustainable long-term funding and infrastructure options.

Next steps

ESDN Liaison roles

- Council liaisons will be the face of ESDN in each region.
 - Framing ESDN as a council benefit.
 - Working with existing partners, recruiting and adding new partners, communicating with interested parties.
- During Phase 2:
 - Liaisons will continue to onboard hosted partners - the partners we've added so far are in, now we need to continue moving toward including as many of our hosted partners as possible - this will mostly be about getting letters.
 - Working with non-hosted partners:
 - Select and outreach to 5 non-hosted partners in Phase 2.
 - Manage uptick in interest and activity -- we want to provide tools to make this new role manageable and sustainable.
- Workflow review
 - For hosted partners - same as before:
 - Get permission letters.
 - Add to Hosted spreadsheet.
 - Work with Chris on mapping.
 - For potential and non-hosted partners:
 - Add to Non-hosted/Potential Partners spreadsheet.
 - If the partner will be hosted, move to Hosted workflow (above).
 - If the partner will be non-hosted, get the permission letter and make introductions to ESDN.

Outreach Tools:

- ESDN website - we've added documentation for contributor and interested parties.
- We've added new materials for liaisons that are available on our shared Google drive.
- Council hosted events - ESDN staff is happy to present at workshops or webinars as needed.
- Liaisons are encouraged to share their own outreach materials with one another.
