### Updates

- Ingest updates
  - We have over 200,000 items in DPLA
    - 59,511 from State Library
    - 11,649 from State Archives (new)
    - 34,893 from NY Philharmonic (new)
    - 36,421 from NY Heritage - 32 Collections from Long Island will go in the next harvest in early-April
  - Chris is continuing to update the shared contributor spreadsheet - the first tab has ingest schedules
- ESDN portal project
  - ESDN staff is continuing to work toward building a NY state portal or front-end using the DPLA-API.
  - We are able to pull all of the records we contribute to DPLA out through the DPLA-API. We have built some very [simple search app](#) with limited faceting based on this data.
  - Next step will be to take our data from the API, pull it into a database where we can add additional terms and enhancements, then output that through some sort of front-end that we hope to have a beta version of by June of this year. That will be our proof of concept for a statewide portal infrastructure.
- DPLAFest 2016

Will be held in Washington DC April 14-15. New York will be well represented through multiple presentations & panels.

### Subgroup Work

- Curriculum group

The curriculum sub-group met for the first time on Feb 25th. This group will be working together to build a digital skills curriculum for the state. Group will begin by compiling some shared training modules for use by all the councils. Since each council provides some level of trainings around digitization and digital skills, our first step will be to gather work already being done at each of the councils. Jen P at SENYLRC is chairing. Eric, Ryan, and Jaclyn have agreed to serve on this group.

- Rights group:  
We will move forward with a Rights group in coming months pending ongoing work from the international Getting it Right on Rights group as they finalize their recommendations for rights statements. This group will be chaired by Anne.

### **Reminders**

- Each council should continue gathering permission letters from members with collections in NY Heritage, HRVH or METRO Digital Culture. We're making great progress in growing representation in DPLA from regionally hosted projects.
- Reminder to reach out to members with locally hosted content. Still working toward a goal of 5 non-hosted partners from each region - we're about half-way there.
